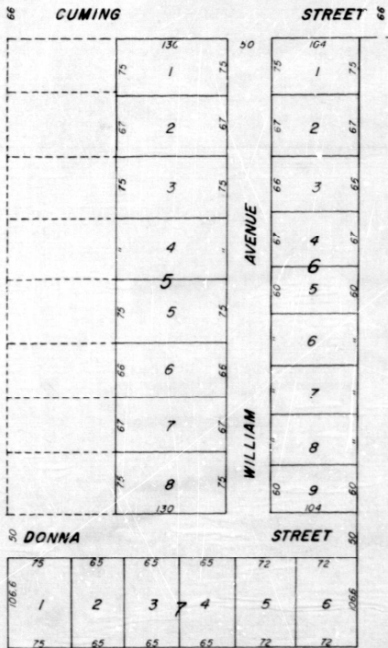


"B" AND "B" THIRD ADDITION TO FREMONT, NEBRASKA

DEDICATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That RAY O. BUCKRIDGE and RUTH D. BUCKRIDGE husband and wife, are the owners of the east 284 feet of lots 9 and 10, and the north 131.60 feet of lot 11, except the north 25 feet of the west 130 feet of lot 11, all in IOWA RAILROAD LAND COMPANY'S SUBDIVISION of part of the west 1/2 of the south east 1/4 of Section 24, Township 17 North, Range 8 East of the 6th P.M., do hereby subdivide and plat said tract as 'B' and 'B' THIRD ADDITION to Fremont, Dodge County, Nebraska. Said subdivision consists of 3 blocks, which are subdivided into lots, their numbers and dimensions shown on this plat.

We dedicate for perpetual use by the public, William Avenue and Donna Street which are 50 feet in width.

An easement across the rear 10 feet of all lots in this addition is hereby reserved for the sole purpose of constructing and maintaining utility lines and pipes.
