Victor R. vonArx and/or Yvonne M. vonArx (husband and wife)

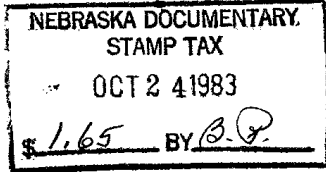
AS JOINT TENANTS, and not as tenants in common, the following described real estate, situated in Cass County, Nebraska, to-wit:

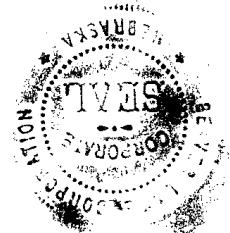
