ORDINANCE NO. 2188

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE NECESSITY, EXPEDIENCY, AND PROPRIETY OF VACATING THAT PORTION OF WARREN STREET LYING BETWEEN BLOCK 24 AND BLOCK 65, IN THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, SARPY COUNTY, NEBRASKA, NOT HERETOFORE VACATED; AND VACATING THE ALLEY IN BLOCK 65, NOT HERETOFORE VACATED; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND ALL PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, AND DESIGNATING EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Bellevue, Nebraska, has determined that no damages will accrue to any citizen of the City of Bellevue, nor to any owners of property herein by reason of the proposed vacation.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. It is hereby necessary, expedient, and proper to vacate that portion of Warren Street lying between Block 24 and Block 65, in the City of Bellevue, Sarpy County, Nebraska, and not heretofore vacated, and the same be and hereby is vacated.

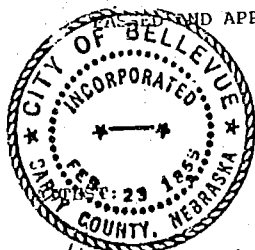
Section 2. It is hereby necessary, expedient, and proper to vacate that portion of the alley in Block 65, not heretofore vacated, and the same be and hereby is vacated.

Section 3. The City of Bellevue hereby reserves to itself an easement over the entire vacated street and alley for any sewer lines, water lines, or utility lines, which are now in place in said street or alley.

Section 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
