ORDINANCE NO. 2287

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE NECESSITY, EXPEDIENCY AND  
PROPERTY OF VACATING THE ALLEY IN BLOCK TWENTY-NINE (29) IN  
THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, SARPY COUNTY, NEBRASKA, EXTENDING FROM  
19TH AVENUE TO THE SOUTH LOT LINE OF LOT FOUR (4), WALDO  
ADDITION, AS PROJECTED, NOT HERETOFORE VACATED; REPEALING ALL  
ORDINANCES AND ALL PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith,  
AND DESIGNATING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bellevue,  
Nebraska, has determined that no damage will accrue to any  
citizen or citizens of the City of Bellevue, nor to any  
owners of property therein by reason of the proposed  
vacation,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, NEBRASKA:

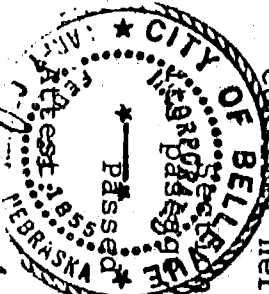
Section 1. It is hereby necessary, expedient and proper  
to vacate the alley in Block Twenty-nine (29) in the City of  
Bellevue, Sarpy County, Nebraska, extending from 19th Avenue  
to the South lot line of Lot Four (4), Waldo Addition, as  
projected, not heretofore vacated and the same be and is  
hereby vacated.

Section 2. There is hereby reserved to the City of  
Bellevue and its agents a permanent easement in said alley  
for utilities, maintenance and installation.

Section 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in  
conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

4. This ordinance shall become effective after  
approval and publication according to law.
