
AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE NECESSITY, EXPEDIENCY AND
PROPRIETY OF VACATING ALL OF THAT PART OF THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF THE
ABANDONED OMAHA AND SOUTHERN RAILWAY, ALSO KNOWN AS BOULEVARD
AVENUE, BETWEEN 19th AVENUE AND 21st AVENUE, WHERE THE SAME INTER-
SECTS BLOCKS 244, 245 AND 272 IN THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, SARPY COUNTY,
NEBRASKA, EXCEPTING THAT PORTION OF SAID RIGHT-OF-WAY WHEREIN THE
~~old~~ STREETS AND AVENUES, AS SURVEYED AND PLATTED, INTERSECT THE SAME,
~~old~~ AND PROJECT ACROSS SAID RIGHT-OF-WAY, AND REPRALING ALL ORDINANCES
~~old~~ OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR THE
~~old~~ APPOINTMENT OF THREE DISINTERESTED FREEHOLDERS TO ASCERTAIN AND
ASSESS THE DAMAGES SUSTAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLEVUE AND BY THE
CITIZENS OF SAID CITY OR BY THE OWNERS OF THE PROPERTY HEREIN BY
REASON OF SUCH PROPOSED VACATION, DEFINING THEIR DUTIES AND PRO-
VIDING FOR THEIR COMPENSATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEL-
LEVUE, NEBRASKA:

Section 1: That it is hereby declared necessary, ex-
pedient and proper for the public good to vacate all of that part
of the right-of-way of the abandoned Omaha and Southern Railway,
also known as Boulevard Avenue, between 19th Avenue and 21st Avenue,
where the same intersects Blocks 244, 245 and 272 in the City of
Bellevue, Sarpy County, Nebraska, excepting that portion of said
right-of-way wherein the streets and avenues, as surveyed and plat-
ted, intersect the same, and project across said right-of-way.

Section 2: That the following named disinterested resi-
dent freeholders are hereby appointed appraisers to ascertain and
assess the damages sustained by the City of Bellevue and by the
citizens of said city or by the owners of property herein by reason
of said proposed vacation: W. L. Cockrell, W. S. Frazier and Waldo
Shallcross.

Said appraisers shall meet within eight (8) days from date hereof to ascertain and assess said damages, and within ten (10) days from date hereof shall file their written report and assessment with the City Clerk; said appraisers shall each receive the sum of One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) per day compensation for their services.

Section 3: That a copy of this ordinance shall be published in the Bellevue Press, a legal newspaper of general circulation in the City of Bellevue, Nebraska, within a period of one month after the passage hereof.

Section 4: This ordinance shall become effective and put in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
