ORDINANCE NO. 125

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE NECESSITY, EXPEDIENCY AND PROPRIETY OF VACATING 21st STREET IN THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, AS NOW ESTABLISHED, FROM VAN BUREN STREET TO CRAWFORD STREET, BETWEEN BLOCKS 301 and 302, FROM LOTS ONE (1) THROUGH TWELVE (12) BLOCK 301, AND FROM LOTS SIX (6) THROUGH SEVEN (7) INCLUSIVE IN BLOCK 302, VACATING SAID STREET AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND DESIGNATING EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. It is hereby declared necessary, expedient and proper for the public good to vacate 21st street in the City of Bellevue, as now established, from Van Buren Street to Crawford Street, between Blocks 301 and 302, from Lots One (1) through twelve (12) Block 301, and from Lots Six (6) through seven (7) inclusive in Block 302, and the aforesaid street, as now established, is hereby declared to be vacated.

Section 2. There is reserved to the City of

the right to use

Section 3. That the appraisers heretofore appointed for the purpose of appraising damages to the citizens of the City of Bellevue and the owners of the property abutting upon the parcel hereinbefore described, by virtue of said proposed vacation, made report as to their findings to the City Clerk of the City of Bellevue, Nebraska, to the effect that there was no damage to any person or property owner or owners by virtue of the vacation.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective and in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication, as provided by law.
