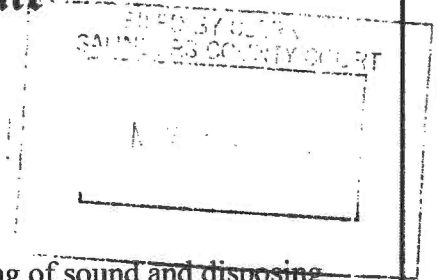

Earl H. Veskerna




I, Earl H. Veskerna, of Mead, Saunders County, Nebraska, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking any and all previous testamentary dispositions heretofore made by me.

FIRST: I hereby appoint my sister, Norma D. Veskerna, as my personal representative and request that she serve without bond. In the event that she declines or is unable to act as my personal representative, I hereby appoint Kerry K. Knuth as my personal representative to also serve without bond.

SECOND: I hereby authorize and direct my said personal representative to pay the expenses of my burial, purchase a suitable headstone for my grave, and pay, from the residue of my estate, all state inheritance taxes and federal estate taxes that may be due by reason of my death. I further empower my personal representative to convert any or all of my real and personal property into cash under such terms and conditions as she deems proper without first obtaining the order or approval of any court, and to distribute my estate in cash or in kind.

THIRD: I hereby declare that I am not married and I have no children. I have two sisters, Norma D. Veskerna and Jeanette K. Knowles.

FOURTH: I devise, give and bequeath all of my estate, whether real or personal, as follows:

- b) All the rest, residue and remainder of my estate I devise to my sister, Norma D. Veskerna. If she predeceases me or disclaims any property or assets devised to her, I devise any such assets, including the family farm, to St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Omaha, Nebraska.

Veskerna, the Testator, sign my name to this instrument, consisting of two pages, this 14th day of June, 2017, and being first duly sworn, do hereby declare to the undersigned authority that I sign and execute this instrument as my Last Will and that I sign it willingly or willingly direct another to sign for me, that I execute it as my free and voluntary act for the purposes therein expressed and that I am eighteen years of age or older or am not at this time a minor, and am of sound mind and under no constraint or undue influence.
