RELEASE OF CERTAIN LOTS FROM PROTECTIVE  
AND RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:


That we the undersigned, MARY CAMENZIND, single, LOUIS CAMENZIND, single, JOHN K. CAMENZIND and BETTY S. CAMENZIND, husband and wife, CARL HOLMQUIST and BEATRICE HOLMQUIST, husband and wife, JOSEPH P. INSERRA and PHYLLIS M. INSERRA, husband and wife; the said Mary Camenzind, Louis Camenzind, John K. Camenzind, Carl Holmquist and Joseph P. Inserra being the sole and only owners in fee simple of all of the real estate in CAMENZIND HIGHLAND SECOND ADDITION, a sub-division as surveyed, platted and recorded in Douglas County, Nebraska, and being all of the fee title owners who adopted and imposed Protective Covenants upon all of such real estate as shown in the "Declaration of Protective Covenants" dated August 20th, 1963 and recorded August 27th, 1963 in the office of the Register of Deeds of Douglas County, Nebraska, where the same appears in Book 401 Misc. records at page 401, having been informed and advised that the Forest Lawn Cemetery Association, a Corporation, is desirous of purchasing two (2) lots adjacent to its Cemetery grounds, upon which it desires in the future to construct a Gateway for purposes of vehicular ingress and egress to the present Cemetery Association property, which construction and use of such lots is now prohibited because of the restrictive covenants in effect, do hereby WAIVE AND RELEASE each and all of the Covenants and Restrictions as set forth in such "Declaration of Protective Covenants", in so far as the same pertain to the property legally described as:

"Lot One (1), Block Seven (7) and Lot Nine (9), Block Ten (10), in Camenzind Highland Second Addition, as surveyed, platted and recorded in Douglas County, Nebraska".

This Waiver and Release shall apply only to the two (2) lots hereinabove described, and shall have no effect upon any other property located within said Camenzind Highland Second Addition.
