ORDINANCE NO. 3011

AN ORDINANCE CREATING PAVING DISTRICT NO. 496 OF THE CITY OF FREMONT, NEBRASKA; AND ORDERING THE CONSTRUCTION OF STREET IMPROVEMENTS THEREIN, PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF THE CREATION OF SAID PAVING DISTRICT; AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE WILL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREMONT, NEBRASKA

SECTION 1. That Paving District No. 496 is hereby created and constituted in the City of Fremont, Nebraska.

SECTION 2. That Paving District No. 496 comprises and includes the paving of that portion of FIFTH STREET from the east margin of Clarmar Avenue to the west margin of Luther Road; and all lots and lands lying north of the north margin of Fifth Street to a depth of 119-feet back from the margin thereof between Luther Road and Howard Street; and all lots and lands lying north of the north margin of Fifth Street to a depth of 160-feet back from the margin thereof between Howard Street and William Avenue; and all lots and lands lying north of the north margin of Fifth Street to a depth of 170.8-feet back from the margin thereof between William Avenue and Clarmar Avenue; and all lots and lands lying south of the south margin of Fifth Street to a depth of 200-feet back from the margin thereof between Clarmar Avenue and Luther Road. Said district being created for the purpose of paving the said street with concrete.

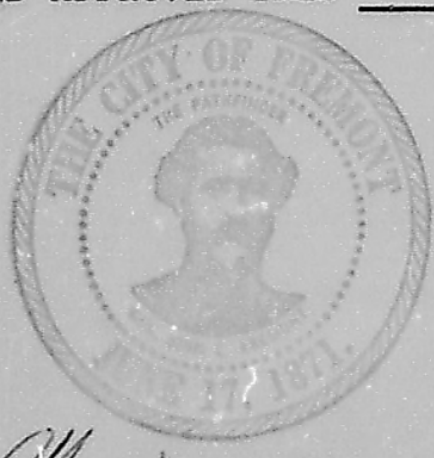
SECTION 3. That authority is granted to assess the entire cost of 6-inch thick, 31-foot wide concrete paving between Howard Street and Luther Road; and 6-inch thick 25-foot wide concrete paving between Clarmar Avenue and Howard Street; all exclusive of intersections and spaces opposite alleys against the property benefited within the margins of said proposed paving district.

SECTION 4. If the owners of record title representing a majority of the front footage in a district whose property abuts or adjoins one continuous or extended thoroughfare or more, as aforesaid and who are such owners at the time the ordinance creating the district is published,

shall file with the City Clerk within twenty (20) days from the first publication of said notice, written objections to the paving of a district, said work shall not be done in said district under said ordinance, but said ordinance shall be repealed. If objections are not filed against any district in the time and manner aforesaid, the Mayor and Council shall forthwith proceed to construct such paving.

Section 5. Notice of the creation of said district shall be published as provided by law in the Fremont Tribune, a legal newspaper published and of general circulation in the City of Fremont, Nebraska.
