Now on this 11th day of September 1972, at a meeting of the Board of County Supervisors of said county, Supervisors Harlan Dierking, Alex Erickel, Waldo Davis, Raymond Bosin, Robert Tomlinson, Don McKamy, \_\_\_\_\_, being present, said board proceeded to canvass the votes cast at the election held on the 29th day of August 1972, in and for the proposed Niobrara Basin Irrigation District for the purpose of voting upon the proposition to organize the territory embraced in said proposed district into an irrigation district under the laws of the State of Nebraska, and for the purpose of establishing said district, and the returns from said election from all of the divisions of said proposed irrigation district being before the Board, the same is canvassed by and the said Board finds:

That at said election a total of 160 votes was cast, and that of said votes so cast 126 votes were "Irrigation District - YES," and 34 votes were "Irrigation District - NO." The Board therefore finds that the proposition for the organization of the Niobrara Basin District carried.

The Board further finds that in the First Division of said District Howard S. Carr received 40 votes for the office of Director for the First Division; that no other person received more than 40 votes for said office; that Howard S. Carr having received a majority of the votes cast for said office was elected to said office; that in the Second Division of said District Alfred T. Drayton received 32 votes for the office of Director for the Second Division; that no other person received more than 32 votes for said office; and that said Alfred T. Drayton having received a majority of the votes cast for said office was elected to said office; that in the Third Division of said District Paul Krugman received

47 votes for the office of Director for the Third District; and that no other person received more than 47 votes for said office; and that said Paul Krugman having received a majority of the votes cast for said office was elected to said office.

The Board further finds that due and legal notice of said election was given as provided by law by publishing notice thereof in the Springview Herald in Keya Paha County, Nebraska, and in the Atkinson Graphic and in the Frontier and Holt County Independent in Holt County, Nebraska, all of which are legal newspapers published in said counties in which said irrigation district is located; that all the proceedings had in connection with said election were in due form and in all things conformed to law; and that the same was in all respects fairly and impartially held and conducted.

IT IS THEREFORE, considered and ordered that the said Niobrara Basin Irrigation District be and the same hereby is declared to be duly and legally organized as an irrigation district under the provisions of the laws of the State of Nebraska, and that Howard S. Carr is duly and legally elected director for Division One; that Alfred T. Drayton is the duly and legally elected director for Division Two; and that Paul Krugman is the duly and legally elected Director for Division Three of said Niobrara Basin Irrigation District.

It is further considered and ordered that said district shall be known as the "Niobrara Basin Irrigation District" and shall constitute the territory as hereinafter bounded and defined, to-wit: Beginning at a point within the State of Nebraska in Keya Paha County at the southwest (SW) corner of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Seventeen (17), Township Thirty-Three (33) North (N), Range Twenty-One (21), West (W) of the Sixth (6th) Principal Meridian; thence North (N) to the northwest (NW) corner of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Five (5); thence East (E) to the northeast (NE) corner of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Five (5); thence East (E) to the northeast (NE) corner of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Ten (10); thence South (S) to the southwest (SW) corner of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Ten (10); thence East (E) to the southeast (SE) corner of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Ten (10);
