

ORDINANCE NO. 5486

AN ORDINANCE vacating the alley between 38th Street and 38th Avenue from Harney Street to Dewey Avenue in the city of Omaha, and providing for the appraisement of the ground vacated and sale of same to the adjoining property owners.

WHEREAS, Property owners representing the entire property abutting on said alley have petitioned for said vacation, therefore BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAHA:

Section 1. That the alley between 38th Street and 38th Avenue from Harney Street to Dewey Avenue in the City of Omaha, be and the same is hereby vacated, the said vacation of said alley to be subject to the sale and disposal of the ground so vacated as hereinafter provided.

Section 2. That it is hereby made the duty of the appraisement committee nominated by the Mayor and confirmed by the city council, to appraise all property belonging to the city, to appraise the ground so vacated opposite each lot or part of lot abutting on said alley such manner as required by ordinance and file a report of such appraisement with the city clerk, who shall thereupon give notice through the official paper in the city for one week; inviting bids for the purchase of said property, such bids, if any, to be hereafter considered and acted upon by the city council as it may deem right and proper.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
