ORDINANCE NO. 12846

01 An Ordinance creating Ornamental Lighting District No. 266, defining the limits thereof,
02 designating the improvements to be made therein, designating the property to be benefited, providing for the payment
03 of the cost thereof, and repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

04 BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

05 Section 1. That Ornamental Lighting District No. 266 be and the same is hereby created; that
06 said ornamental lighting district is created for the purpose of acquiring and installing ornamental lights, including poles,
07 fixtures, wiring, underground conduits, and all necessary equipment and accessories, in or along the following described
08 street, streets, public grounds, public way or ways, within the City of Lincoln, Nebraska, to-wit: South 16th
09 Street, South 17th Street and Windhoek Drive located in Lincoln Industrial Park
10 South.

11 that said ornamental lighting district shall include the following described real estate benefited, to-wit: all of
12 Lincoln Industrial Park South; and the remaining portions of Lot 1, Block 2,
13 Cushman Replat.

14 The cost of acquiring and installing said ornamental lights, including poles, fixtures, wiring, underground
15 conduits, and all necessary equipment and accessories, and all other expenses incidental thereto, shall be assessed
16 proportionately to the benefits on the property specially benefited in said district, not exceeding the special benefits
17 accruing on account thereof.

18 Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.

19 Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after passage and publication according to
20 law but construction shall not be commenced until ordered by resolution by the City Council.
