THENEFORE be it resolved that the following described territory be, and it hereby is incorporated as a village as provided by law, to-wit: Commencing at the South East corner of the Worth West Quarter of section Seven, Township Eight, Range Eight, thence east 57 rods, thence south 57 rods, thence west 40 rods west of Adaws County line, thence North 274 rods, thence East 250 rode, thence south to the south fine of the C.B.& Q. R. R. Co. right of way, thence in South westerly direction following said right of way to the east line of the said North West Quarter of section 7, Township 8, Range 8, thence South to point of beginning. See it further resolved that the following named citizans and residents of said territory be and they are hereby appointed as Board of Trustees of said village as provided by law:
