Trumbull Incor.

The following petition was presented:

To the Honorable Board Of County Commissioners of the County of Clay and State of Nebraska, Your undersigned petitioners respectfully represent unto your Honorable board that Trumbull is an un-incorporated Village situated within the County of Clay and State of Nebraska, containing two hundred actual residents, and that your petitioners are residents of said village and that the undersigned are a majority of all the taxable inhabitants of said Village. Your petitioners therefore pray that the said Village be incorporated in pursuance of the Statutes in such case provided, and said Village be named Trumbull. That the said corporation shall comprise the certain tract of land known and described by metes and bounds as follows, viz; Commencing at the South East corner of the North West Quarter of section Seven, Township 8, Range 8, thence east 57 rods, thence south 57 rods, thence west 40 rods west of Adams County line, thence North 274 rods, thence East 237 rods, thence south to the South line of O B & Q. R. R. Co. right of way to the east line of the said North West Quarter of section 7, Township 8, Range 8, thence South to point of beginning.

The following resolution seconded by Supr Ingalsbe, was adopted:

R E S O L U T I O N.

Whereas it appearing that a majority of the taxable inhabitants of the territory hereinafter described, situate in the Counties of Clay and Adams, State of Nebraska, have duly presented a petition to this board praying that said territory may be incorporated as a village under the name of "Trumbull" and, Whereas it appearing that said territory has inhabitants in excess of one hundred who are actual bona fide residents of said territory.

THEREFORE be it resolved that the following described territory be, and it hereby is incorporated as a village as provided by law, to-wit: Commencing at the South East corner of the North West Quarter of section Seven, Township Eight, Range Eight, thence east 57 rods, thence south 57 rods, thence west 40 rods west of Adams County line, thence North 274 rods, thence East 237 rods, thence south to the south line of the U. S. & Q. R. R. Co. right of way, thence in South westerly direction following said right of way to the east line of the said North West Quarter of section 7, Township 8, Range 8, thence South to point of beginning. Be it further resolved that the following named citizens and residents of said territory be and they are hereby appointed as Board or Trustees of said village as provided by law: George Washburn, J. Combs, James Rollstin, Clint Gossard and Wallace Martin.

Be it further resolved that the Clerk of this Board be instructed to enter this order of incorporation upon the records of the County of Clay and state of Nebraska and to make proper certificate thereof to the County Clerk of Adams County, Nebraska and that said territory above described be hereafter known and designated as the village of "Trumbull".
