


MHEREAS, on September 22, 1947 the owners, with the exception of one, of the real estate abutting on Izard Street between 70th Avenue and 72nd Street; Nicholas Street between 70th Avenue and 71st Street; and Seventy-first Street from Izard to Western Avenue, and also the alleys running east and west from 70th Avenue to 71st Street between Izard and Nicholas Streets, from 70th Avenue to 71st Street between Nicholas Street and Western Avenue, and from Izard to Western Avenue between 71st and 72nd Street, being those alleys in Blocks 1, 2 and 3, Otis Place, filed a petition for the vacation of said streets and alleys, and said petition has been signed by at least ten electors, residing within five miles of the road proposed to be vacated, and said petition substantially complies with the requirements of Section 31-105, Nevised Statutes of Nebraska for 1943; and


WHEREAS, the County Surveyor has made an investigation in compliance with the requirements of Sections 39-107, 39-108, 39-109 and 39-110, R. S. 1943, advising the County Board that said vacation is in his opinion expedient, taking into consideration both the public and private convenience; and

WHEREAS, the County Attorney has advised in a formal written opinion that it is not necessary that all adjacent or contiguous property owners consent to the proposed vacation, but that it is legally sufficient if a majority of the voters living within two miles of the road proposed to be vacated consent to such vacation; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds as a fact that a majority of the voters living within two miles of the road and not living in a village or city have and do consent to the proposed vacation.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the resolution adopted May 6, 1947 granting permission for the vacation of Nicholas Street from Seventieth Avenue to Seventy-first Street; and Seventy-first Street from Izard to Western Avenue and also the alleys running east and west from Seventieth Avenue to Seventy-first Street between Izard and Nicholas Streets, and from Seventieth Avenue to Seventy-first Street between Nicholas Street and Western Avenue, be and is hereby rescinded, and
