

MODIFICATION AND RELEASE OF PROTECTIVE COVENANTS

The undersigned, being the owners of all of the following described real estate:

All of Blocks One (1), Two (2), Three (3) and Four (4), Tower Plaza, an Addition in Douglas County, Nebraska,

in consideration of the mutual covenants and releases by each of the undersigned herein contained, do hereby modify and release certain Protective Covenants covering the above-described real estate, acknowledged January 13, 1947 by Godfrey Malec, President, and Joseph Malec, Secretary-Treasurer, of Peony Park (a corporation), and filed January 23, 1947 and recorded in Book 219 at Page 601 of the Miscellaneous Records of Douglas County, Nebraska; such modification and release to be as follows:

1. Said Block One (1) in Tower Plaza shall be and is hereby absolutely and forever exempted and fully released from any and all said Protective Covenants.

2. With regard to Blocks Two (2), Three (3) and Four (4) in said Tower Plaza, such covenants shall be and are hereby amended as follows:

(a) Paragraph C shall be and is hereby wholly amended as follows:

"No building shall be erected nearer to the front lot line nor nearer to the side street line than the building set back lines shown on the recorded plat. In any event, no building shall be located on any residential building plot nearer than 35 feet to the front lot line, nor nearer than 5 feet to any side street line. No building, except a detached garage or other outbuilding located 35 feet or more from the front lot line, shall be located nearer than 5 feet to any side lot line."

(b) All other provisions of said Protective Covenants shall remain in full force and effect.

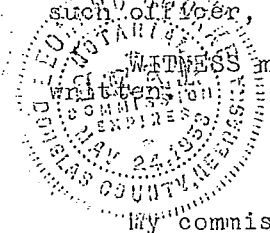
