BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

Section 1. That the east-west alley between R Street and S Street from N. 8th Street to N. 9th Street, in Block 21, Original Plat, Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska, and abutting Lots 3 - 6, Block 21, Original Plat, Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska; Lot G, Dinges & McGahey's Subdivision, Lincoln, Lancaster County Nebraska; and Lots 1 and 2, The Arts and Humanities Block Addition, Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska, be and the same is hereby vacated, subject to the title of said alley being vacated remaining in the City of Lincoln, Nebraska.

Section 2. That, pursuant to paragraph 11.b of the Redevelopment Agreement (Sawmill Project) approved by Resolution No. A-84771, said vacated east-west alley is hereby authorized to be conveyed to the abutting property owners without additional consideration, except for the grant of new easements for the LES electrical lines and switch boxes as follows: the south half of the vacated alley to Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska; the north half of the vacated alley abutting Lot G, Dinges & McGahey's Subdivision, and the east half of Lot 3, Block 21, Original Plat, to the Nebraska Press Advertising Service, Inc.; and the north half of the vacated alley abutting the west half of Lot 3 and Lots 4 - 6, Block 21, Original Plat, to the Sawmill Building Partnership.
