PERPETUAL CARE AGREEMENT.

In consideration of the payment in full of the purchase price of the within described lot, the West Lawn Cemetery agrees to set apart as a trust fund for the perpetual care of all lots in the cemetery, 20 per cent. of the gross income from the sale of lots under the following conditions:

Said trust fund to be known as "Perpetual Care Fund", shall be hald together with other trust funds entirely separate and apart from other funds of said cemetery and to use the utmost care and discretion in safeguarding the funds so held in trust in selecting depositaries and in making investments.

The West Lawn Cemetery guarantees perpetual care of the lot within described so long as it shall be used as a place of burial by the purchaser, his heirs or devisees, and will retain as payment for such perpetual care, the imcome from the permanent fund.

The term "Perpetual Care" shall mean the cutting of the grass upon said lot at reasonable intervals; the raking and cleaning of the lot; the pruning of the shrubs and trees; and such work as may be necessary to keep the lot in good and near condition; meaning and intending to continue forever similar work to that now regularly done upon all the lots and graves in West Lawn Cemetery along these lines. In addition to this, the Cemetery hereby binds itself to keep in repair and maintain in good condition the enclosures, buildings, drives, walks and borders in said cemetery.

Under this agreement, however, the Cemetery does not bind itself to maintain, repair or replace any grave stones or monumental structures erected upon the lot or the grave therein, nor to do any special or unusual work such as planting flowers or ornamental plants.
