containing an area of 4.0 acres, more or less.

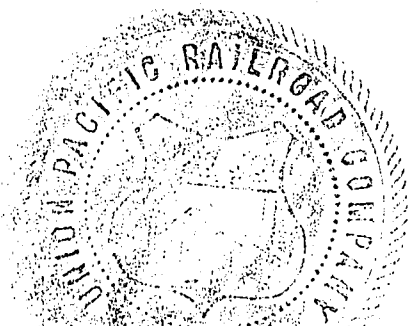

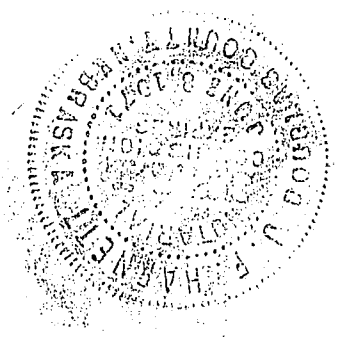
