## RELEASE OF PERMANENT EASEMENT

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 35775, passed November 13, 2001 vacated the north/south alley between 23<sup>rd</sup> Street and 24<sup>th</sup> Street from Spring Street to Vinton Street, abutted by Lots 1 through 16, Block 28, Wilcox 2<sup>nd</sup> Addition, said Ordinance recorded in Miscellaneous Book 1411, Page 142 of the Douglas County Register of Deeds Office; and,
