Resolved.

WHEREAS, the Dugdale Construction Company, Henry L. Krogh, Elizabeth T. Krogh and Lee V. Horton, owners of all the real property abutting that portion of 86th Street lying between Block Two (2) and Block Three (3) in West Benson, a Subdivision, as surveyed, platted and recorded, and extending from the south line of the right-of-way of Maple Street southward to Miami Street at a line comprising a southward extension of the East line of Lot 29 in said Block Three (3), in Douglas County, Nebraska, did on July 1st, 1952, file in the office of the County Commissioners a petition requesting the vacation of that said portion of a street above described, and

WHEREAS, this request has been carefully investigated by the County Surveyor, who under date of July 7th, 1952, recommended that portion of 86th Street between Maple and Miami Streets, be vacated.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the vacation of that portion of 86th Street between Maple and Miami Streets, as above described, be and is hereby accepted and approved provided however that the vacation of the property herein described, and the revision thereof, shall be subject to the condition and limitation that there is reserved to the Metropolitan Utilities District of the City of Omaha, the Omaha Public Power District, Northwestern Bell Telephone Company or any other public utility the right to construct, maintain, repair, renew and operate present existing or hereafter installed water mains, pole lines, conduits and other similar services or equipment above, on and below the surface of the ground for the purpose of serving the general public or abutting property; and the right so reserved shall also include such lateral connections or branch lines as may be ordered, desired or permitted by the County; and to enter upon the premises to accomplish the above purpose at any and all times, and that the County Surveyor be and is hereby authorized and directed to correct the records, profiles and plats accordingly and that a copy of this resolution be filed in the Register of Deed's Office and the cost of same be charged to the petitioners.
