

CORPORATION QUITCLAIM DEED - STREET PURPOSES

The grantor, Continental Can Company, Inc., a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of New York, in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration in hand paid, received from grantee, does quitclaim, grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto City of Omaha, a Municipal Corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the Laws of State of Nebraska, herein called "grantee", for street purposes, the following described real property in Douglas County, Nebraska:

Tract of land for additional right-of-way for 72nd Street lying in the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of Section One (1), Township Fourteen (14) North, Range Twelve (12) East of the 6th Principal Meridian, Douglas County, Nebraska, more particularly described as follows: Commencing at a point 33.0 Feet South and 33.0 Feet East of the Northwest Corner of the Northwest Quarter of said Section One, running thence South 00°, 00' West along the existing right-of-way line of 72nd Street, a distance of 1,173.50 Feet to the point of beginning of land to be conveyed; thence South 00°, 00' West along the existing right-of-way line of 72nd Street, a distance of 100.0 Feet, thence South 89°, 53', 00" East, a distance of 9.0 Feet, thence North 00°, 00' East, a distance of 100.0 Feet; thence North 89°, 54', 00" West, a distance of 9.0 Feet to the point of beginning which is on the existing right-of-way line of 72nd Street. (The center line of 72nd Street assumed north - south in direction.)

Area of acquisition 900 sq. ft.

To have and to hold the above described premises together with all tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the grantee and to grantee's successors and assigns forever.
