

In consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned owner(s) of the real estate hereinafter described, his/her its/their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, hereinafter called "Grantor", hereby grant and convey to OMAHA PUBLIC POWER DISTRICT, a public corporation, its successors and assigns, hereinafter called "District", a permanent right-of-way easement to survey, construct, reconstruct, relocate, alter, inspect, repair, replace, add to, maintain and operate thereon, electric transmission lines consisting of poles, pole foundations, towers, tower foundations, down guys, anchors, insulators, wires, underground cables, supports and other necessary fixtures and equipment over, upon, above, along, under, in and across the following described real estate, to wit: The Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Eight (8), Township Thirteen (13) North, Range Twelve (12), East of the 6th P. M., Sarpy County, Nebraska.

the area of the above described real estate to be covered by this easement shall be as follows: A strip of land One Hundred Fifty feet (150') in width, being Seventy-five feet (75') on each side of and parallel to the following described reference line: Beginning at a point on the South line of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Eight (8), said point being Seven Hundred feet (700'), more or less, East of the Southwest corner thereof; thence in a Northerly direction to a point of leaving located on the North line thereof, said point being Seven Hundred feet (700'), more or less, East of the Northwest corner thereof.

The District agrees to restore to original condition any terrace damage during the exercise of any of the herein granted rights, also to restore to original condition any damage to waterways.

CONDITIONS:

- (a) The District shall have the right of ingress and egress across the Grantor's property for any purpose hereinbefore granted. Such ingress and egress shall be exercised in a reasonable manner.
- (b) The District shall also have the right to trim or remove all trees and brush on said right-of-way as may be necessary to efficiently exercise any of the hereinbefore granted rights, together with the express provision that any and all trees which, in falling would come within 15 feet of the nearest electric line conductor, may be topped or removed. All refuse from such tree cutting or trimming shall be disposed of by the District, and the District shall have the further right to control and impede the growth of all weeds, trees, and brush along the described right-of-way if said right-of-way is not being utilized for cultivated crops.
- (c) The District shall pay the Grantor or Lessee, as their interests may appear, for all damages to growing crops, fences and buildings on said land which may be caused by the exercise of the hereinbefore granted rights.
- (d) Grantor may cultivate, use and enjoy the land within the right-of-way provided that such use shall not, in the judgement of the District, endanger or be a hazard to or interfere with the hereinbefore granted rights and provided further that the Grantor shall not allow any buildings, structures, hay or straw stacks or other property to remain or be placed upon the above described easement area, or change or alter the grade of the right-of-way herein described without the prior written approval from the District.
- (e) It is further agreed that Grantor has lawful possession of said real estate, good, right and lawful authority to make such conveyance and that his/her its/their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns shall warrant and defend the same and will indemnify and hold harmless the District forever against the claims of all persons whomsoever in any way asserting any right, title or interest prior to or contrary to this conveyance.

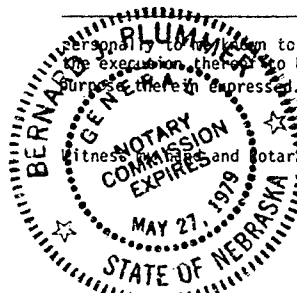
