

AN ORDINANCE to designate the Kent Apartments, located at 832 and 834 South 24th Street and 907 South 25th Street as a Landmark pursuant to the Landmark Heritage Preservation Ordinance of the City of Omaha.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAHA:

Section 1. That the Kent Apartments are located at 832 and 834 South 24th Street and 907 South 25th Street, which is on the following described land, to wit:

Lot 33, Block 0, Redicks 2nd Addition to the City of Omaha, Douglas County, Nebraska.

Section 2. That for the reasons recited in Landmarks Heritage Preservation Commission Resolution attached hereto as Exhibit I, and made a part hereof as if fully set forth herein, the architectural characteristics of the Kent Apartments are hereby deemed significant and worthy of preservation.

Section 3. That the Kent Apartments are hereby designated pursuant to Section 24-61 of the Omaha Municipal Code, and hereby subject to all of the provisions of Landmark Heritage Preservation, Ch. 24, Art. II. of the City of Omaha.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and take effect fifteen (15) days from and after the date of its passage.

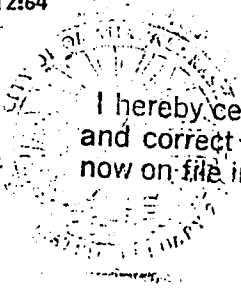
