CONVEYANCE AND ASSIGNMENT

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 15 day of March, 1966, between GREAT LAKES PIPE LINE COMPANY, a corporation duly organized, incorporated and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Delaware, with its principal office at 1102 Grand Avenue, Kansas City, Missouri, hereinafter called "Grantor", and WILLIAMS BROTHERS PIPE LINE COMPANY, a corporation duly organized, incorporated and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Delaware, with its principal office at 1102 Grand Avenue, Kansas Missouri, hereinafter called "Grantee",

WITNESSETH: THAT GRANTOR, in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration to it paid by Grantee, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents SELL, ASSIGN AND CONVEY unto Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, the easements and/or right-of-way grants and agreements listed in Exhibit "A", over, under, upon, across and through lands described in said Exhibit "A" and situate in Seward County and State of NEBRASKA, which said Exhibit "A" is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, to the same purpose, extent, and effect as if physically copied herein, and this instrument assigns and transfers all rights of the Grantor under such easements and grants.

EXCEPTING from this grant such portions of the easements and grants as have been heretofore released, condemned, or quit-claimed, all as shown in Exhibit "A".

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD such, subject to the aforesaid exception, with all and singular the rights, privileges, appurtenances and immunities thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining unto the Grantee and unto its successors and assigns forever; the said Grantor hereby covenanting that such are free and clear from any incumbrance done or suffered by it, except as hereinbefore mentioned; and that Grantor will warrant and defend the title to such unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by, through or under GREAT LAKES PIPE LINE COMPANY, but against none other.

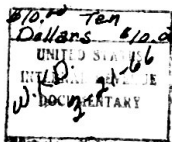

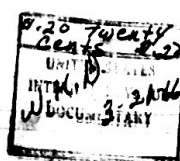
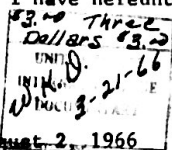
