Resolved, WHEREAS, Robert C. Hastings, Trustee and Natalie H. Crowley, Trustees, owners of Lots 13, 14, 21 and 22, Block 31, Bowling Green and all Blocks 1 to 8, inclusive, Beckwith Place, and Gerald P. Peters, owner of Lots 23 and 24, Block 31, Bowling Green in Douglas County, as surveyed, platted and recorded, did on September 9, 1948 file in the office of the County Commissioners an instrument requesting that all of the alleys now platted upon said real estate be vacated, and

WHEREAS, this matter has been carefully investigated by the County Surveyor, who under date of September 28, 1948 recommended said petition be granted.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the vacation of the alleys as above described, be and is hereby accepted and approved provided however that the vacation of the property herein described, and the revision thereof, shall be subject to the condition and limitation that there is reserved to the Metropolitan Utilities District of the City of Omaha, the Omaha Public Power District, Northwestern Bell Telephone Company or any other public utility the right to construct, maintain, repair, renew and operate present existing or hereafter installed water mains, pole lines, conduits and other similar services or equipment above, on and below the surface of the ground for the purpose of serving the general public or abutting property; and the right so reserved shall also include such lateral connections or branch lines as may be ordered, desired or permitted by the County; and to enter upon the premises to accomplish the above purpose at any and all times, and that the County Surveyor be and is hereby authorized and directed to correct the records, profiles and plats accordingly and that a copy of this resolution be filed in the Register of Deed's Office.


