ORDINANCE NO. 116

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RESTRICTED RESIDENCE DISTRICTS. ESTABLISHING RULES AND RECULATIONS, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF OGDEN, IOWA. Section 1. In order to regulate and control the use of buildings hereimafter to be erected, altered or moved, there is hereby established within the Town of Ogden, a restricted residence district. Section 2. The following residence districts are hereby created:

District No. 1: All that area lyings south of a line commencing at the intersection of Walnut Street at West Town limits, thence east along Walnut Street to the intersection with Seventh Street, thence South along Seventh Street, thence East along Mulberry Street, thence East along Mulberry Street to its intersection with Seventh Street to the intersection with Seventh Street, thence East along Mulberry Street to the east Town limits.

District No. 2: All that area between First Street on the East and Fifth Street on the West lying north of a line commencing at the corner of Sycamore and First Streets, thence West along Sycamore Street to Founth Street, thence South a distance of 132 feet along Fourth Street to alley, thence West along alley to Fifth Street.

Section 3. (a) It shall be unlawful to erect reconstruct, alter, repair or use any building or struc-

ture, except residences or resident outbuildings within restricted resi-dence districts without first secur-ing a permit from the Town Coun-

ing a permit from the Town Council.

(b) Before a permit shall be issued there shall be filed with the Mayor a detailed plan and specifications for such building or structure to be erected, reconstructed, altered, repaired or used and the Mayor shall publish notice of a time and place of hearing on such application for permit at least five days in advance of hearing by one publication in a newspaper printed and published in Osden, Iowa, describing the real estate on which the proposed building is to be erected, reconstructed, altered, repaired or, used and, pursuant thereto, the Council shall shold a meeting at which time objections, if any, may be heard. If no objections are filed the Council shall shold a meeting at which time objections, if any may be heard. If no objections are filed the Council may, if in its judgment such permit should not be granted, refuse to grant the same, or the Council may, if in its judgment such permit should be granted, issue same notwithstanding objections thereto. Granting a permit shall require the affirmative vote of four Councilmen.

(c) Prior to such hearing on the application the applicant shall pay

Councilmen.

(c) Prior to such hearing on the application the applicant shall pay the costs of publication and proof thereof shall be filed by applicant with the Clerk prior to said hearing.

Section 4. It shall be unlawful to move a building or structure of any kind, from without to within a restricted residence district, or from one location in a restricted residence district without securing a permit pursuant to Section 3 of this Ordinance.

Section 5. It shall be unlawful to use or occupy any property within

district.

(a) The term residence, as used in this Ordinance, shall not include a Mobile Home as defined by Chapter 321 of the Code of Iowa, 1966. A permit shall be required whenever such a structure is moved into or moved within a restricted residence district. A Mobile Home is hereby declared to be an added burden and disedvantage to the residences within a restricted residence district.

Section 6. It shall be unlawful to erect, construct, alter or repair any building within a restricted residence district, so that any part of such building within a restricted residence district, so that any part of such building will be nearer the street than the average of the distance from the street of the two adjoining buildings, one on each side.

Section 7. Any building or structure erected, reconstructed, altered, repaired or used in violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed a nuisance, and it shall be abated by action in the District Court. Such action for abatement shall be prosecuted in the name of the municipality and it shall be the duty of the Mayor and the Town Attorney to procedute such action for ubatement.

Section 8. Within five days after the Ordinance becomes effective the Town Clerk shall prepare or have prepared a plat of the restricted residence districts as established by this Ordinance and certify such Ordinance and after its publication.
