Homestead Certificate No 4437. Application 8949.  
Whereas there has been deposited in the General  
Land Office of the United States a certificate  
of the Register of the Land Office at Lincoln  
Nebraska whereby it appears that, pursuant

to the Act of Congress approved 20<sup>th</sup> May, 1862. To secure Homesteads  
to actual Settlers on the "Public Domain" and the acts supplemental thereto  
the claim of Ezekiel Irwin Turner has been established and duly  
consummated, in conformity to law, for the North West quarter of  
Section Twenty two, in Township Seven, North, of Range Two, East, in the  
District of Lands subject to sale at Lincoln, Nebraska, containing  
one hundred and Sixty acres according to the Official Plat of the  
survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Survey-  
or General;

Now Know Ye, that there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto  
the said Ezekiel Irwin Turner, the tract of Land above described; To Have  
and to Hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto  
the said Ezekiel Irwin Turner and to his heirs and assigns forever  
In Testimony Whereof, J. Ulysses S. Grant, President of the United  
States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the  
Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed:
