



WARRANTY DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT I or WE,

in consideration of One Dollar and other valuable consideration do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto

herein called the grantee whether one or more, the following described real property in Nebraska:

Douglas

County.

Lot 7, except the South 20 feet thereof, Lots 8, 9 and 10, in Block 68, in City of South Omaha, now part of the City of Omaha, as surveyed, platted and recorded, in Douglas County, Nebraska, and that part of vacated 28th Street adjoining on the West.

To have and to hold the above described premises together with all tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the grantee and to grantee's heirs and assigns forever.

And the grantor does hereby covenant with the grantee and with grantee's heirs and assigns that grantor is lawfully seized of said premises; that they are free from encumbrance except covenants, easements and restrictions of record; all regular taxes and special assessments, except those levied or assessed subsequent to date hereof; that grantor has good right and lawful authority to convey the same; and that grantor warrants and will defend the title to said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
