To all to whom these presents shall come greeting  
Whereas there has been deposited in the  
General Land office of the United States a  
Certificate of the Register of the Land office  
at Beatrice Nebraska whereby it appears that pursuant to the act of  
Congress approved 20<sup>th</sup> May 1862. "To Secure Homesteads to actual  
settlers on the Public domain" and the acts Supplemental thereto, the  
claim of Thomas J Taylor has been established and duly con-  
-mated in conformity to law for the

South half of the South East quarter  
of Section Thirty in township Six North of range three east in  
the district of lands subject to sale at Beatrice Nebraska containing  
Eighty acres, according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said  
Land returned to the General Land office by the Surveyor General  
Wm Sum Ye. That there is therefore granted by the United States unto  
the said Thomas J Taylor the tract of land above described:

To have and to hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof  
unto the said Thomas J Taylor and to his heirs and assigns forever

In Testimony Whereof I Rutherford B Hayes, President of the United  
States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent and  
the Seal of the General Land office to be hereunto affixed  
Given under my hand at the City Washington the Thirtieth day  
of June in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and  
Seventy nine and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred  
and third
