ORDINANCE NO. 18406

1 AN ORDINANCE vacating the remaining portion of North 47th Street between the  
2 north line of W Street and the south line of the vacated Missouri Pacific Railroad, and retaining title  
3 thereto in the City of Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska.

4 BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

5 Section 1. That the remaining portion of the North 47th Street right-of-way  
6 between the north line of W Street and the south line of the vacated Missouri Pacific Railroad right-  
7 of-way, located in the Northwest Quarter of Section 20, Township 10 North, Range 7 East of the  
8 6th P.M., Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska, be and the same is hereby vacated, subject to the  
9 title of said street portion being vacated remaining in the City of Lincoln, Nebraska.

10 Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after  
11 its passage and publication according to law.
