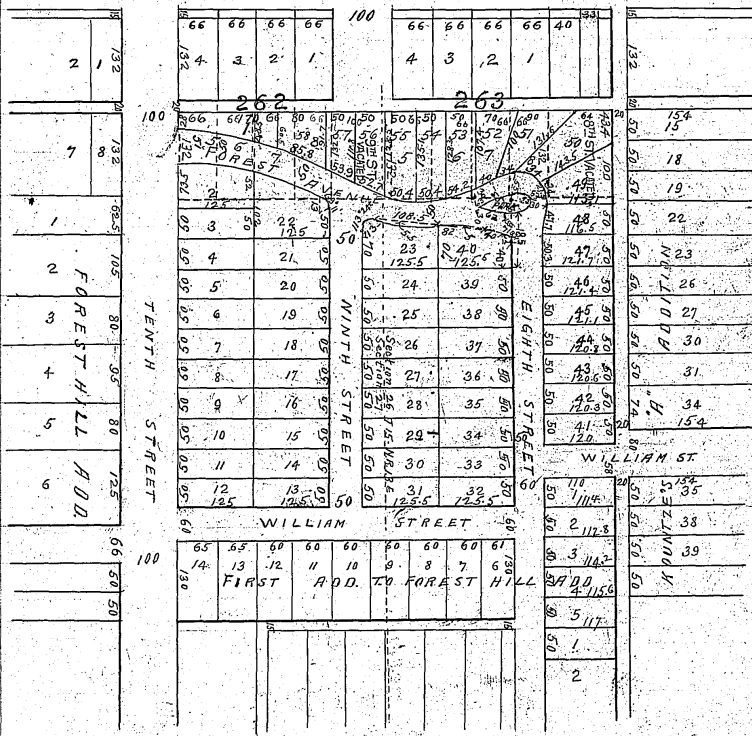

# FOREST HILL PARK



I hereby certify that I have accurately surveyed and staked out the Lots, Streets, Avenues and the Public Park as shown on the accompanying plat of Forest Hill Park, in the City of Omaha, and that the same is located upon the land described in the within dedication.

Know all men by these presents, that the Elizabeth Kountze Real Estate Company, a Nebraska corporation, owner and proprietor of a tract of land consisting of Lots number five (5) Six (6) Seven (7) and Eight (8) in Block Number Two Hundred and Sixty two (262) and Lots Number Five (5) Six (6)

Seven (7) and eighth (8) in Block number two hundred and sixty three (263) in the City of Omaha, Nebraska, a part of eighth (8) Street, vacated, a part of ninth (9) Street, vacated, a part of Tax Lot Number Four (4) in Section number twenty six (26), a part of Tax Lot Number One (1) in Section number twenty seven (27) of Township Number Fifteen (15) North of Range, number thirteen (13) East of the Sixth (6) Principal Meridian; said tract being described as follows:

Beginning on the east line of tenth (10) Street at the northwest corner of Lot Number Five (5) in Block number two hundred and sixty two (262) in the City of Omaha, and running thence South along the east line of tenth Street Six hundred fifty two and five tenths (652.5) feet to the north line of William Street, thence east along the north line of William Street Five hundred and fifty one (551) feet to the west line of eighth Street, thence north along the west line of eighth Street One hundred and eleven (111) feet to the north line of William Street produced westward, thence east along the north line of William Street produced and the north line of William Street One hundred and seventy (170) feet to the west line of the alley west of A. Kountze's addition, thence along the west line of said alley North, Five hundred forty three and four tenths (543.4) feet to the south line of the alley in Block number two hundred sixty three (263) City of Omaha, produced eastward, thence west Seven hundred and twenty four (724) feet to the point of beginning.

Has caused said tract of land to be subdivided and platted into lots, numbered as they appear on the within plat, to be hereafter known as Forest Hill Park, and it does hereby dedicate to the public the Streets and Avenues for use as such, and does hereby dedicate for Park purposes that portion of Forest Avenue marked Park.
