KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that Ralston Townsite Company, a corporation, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Nebraska, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) in hand paid, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant and demise unto Chicago, Burlington and Quincy Railroad Company, its successors and assigns, the right-of-way for and the right to construct, maintain and operate a standard railroad tract or tracts, over and upon a thirty (30) foot strip of land lying between blocks fifty-eight (58) and fifty-nine (59) in the town of Ralston, Douglas County, Nebraska, according to the recorded plat thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Chicago, Burlington and Quincy Railroad Company, its successors and assigns so long as a railroad tract, or tracts, are constructed and operated upon the demised premises.

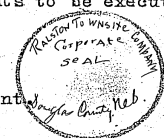
