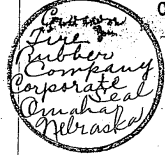
Present - A. A. Arter, R. E. Wilcox, E. C. Brunner; one member absent, Mr. Rex Ehle.

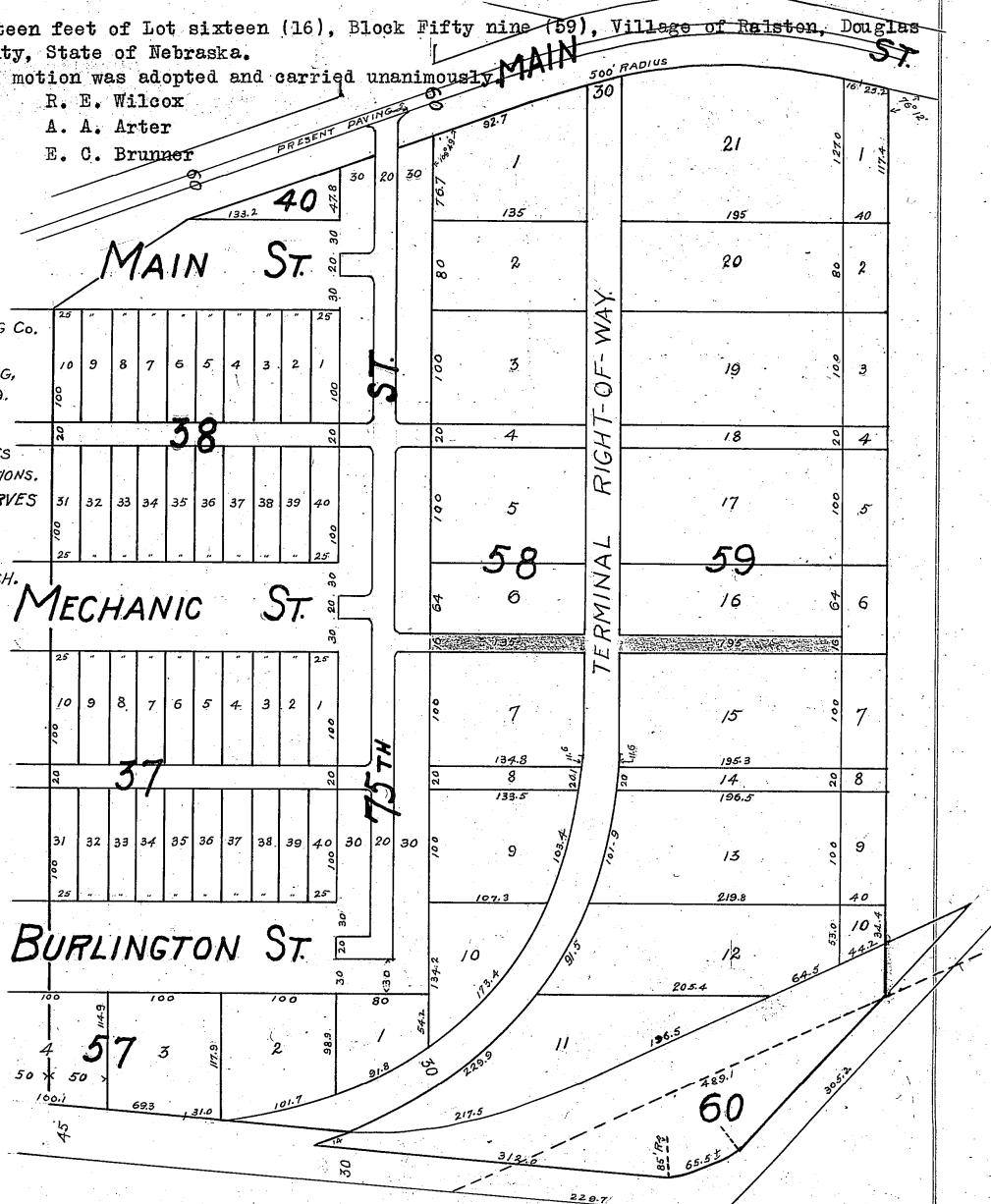
