



X Ordinance No. 23
Village of Friend
Filed June 4. 1884. A. 4. P. M.

An ordinance to extend
the boundaries of the village
of Friend Nebraska.
Be it ordained by the

Chairman and board of Trustees of the Village of Friend Nebraska that the line its and boundaries of said Village of Friend Nebraska be and the same are hereby extended so as to include a portion of the North East quarter of Section Twenty Three (23) Town Eight (8) North of Range one (1) east of the Sixth Principal meridian lying contiguous to the Corporate line its of said Village and more particularly founded and described as follows to wit: Commencing at the north west corner of the north east quarter of Section Twenty Three (23) Town 8, North of Range one (1) east of the sixth principal meridian: thence east to the north east corner of said section thence south to the

south east corner of J. J. Ainsworths first addition to Friend Nebraska. thence west to the southwest corner of said addition to said town. thence north to a Point on the west side of Sycamore Street opposite the north West Corner of Lot numbered six in block numbered thirteen in J. Ainsworths first addition as aforesaid. thence west to the south west corner of B. G. Pages first addition to the town of Friend. thence North to the Place of beginning. All of the Land bounded and described as aforesaid is hereby annexed to and made a part of the corporate village of Friend and shall hereafter enjoy all the privileges and benefits and be subject to all the laws and ordinances now governing the original corporate Village of Friend. The preliminary steps having been regularly and legally had as provided in section ninety five (95) of Chapter fourteen (14) of the compiled Statutes of the State of Nebraska It is hereby declared that this Ordinance shall be enforced and take effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication according to law.




