ORDINANCE NO. 17732

1 AN ORDINANCE creating Ornamental Lighting District No. 283, defining the limits
2 thereof, designating the improvements to be made therein, designating the property to be
3 benefitted, providing for the payment of the cost thereof, and repealing all ordinances and parts
4 of ordinances in conflict herewith.

5 BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

6 Section 1. That Ornamental Lighting District No. 283, be and the same is hereby
7 created for the purpose of acquiring and installing ornamental lights, including poles, fixtures,
8 wiring, underground conduits, and all necessary equipment and accessories, in or along the
9 following described street, streets, public grounds, public way or ways, within the City of
10 Lincoln, Nebraska, to-wit: Woods Avenue from South 33rd Street East to South 38th Street.

11 Section 2. Said Ornamental Lighting District shall include the following described real
12 estate benefitted, to-wit: Lots 18 through 33, Block 8 and Lots 4 through 8, Block 7 and lots 7
13 through 11, Block 6, Lots 14, 15, 16 Block 1 Youngs Hyland Park. And Lots 1 through 14,
14 Block 10 and Lots 1 through 8, Block 11 and Lots 1 through 6, Block 12 and Lot A, Block 12
15 Hyland Park Annex located in the Northeast Quarter of Section 30, Township 10 North, Range
16 7 East of the 6th Principal Meridian in the City Of Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska.

17 Section 3. The cost of acquiring and installing said ornamental lights, including poles,
18 fixtures, wiring, underground conduits, and all necessary equipment and accessories, and all other
19 expenses incidental thereto, shall be assessed proportionately to the benefits on the property
20 specially benefitted in said district, not exceeding the special benefits accruing on account thereof.

21 In the event that easements or additional right-of-way must be acquired for the completion of this

1 district, such property rights may be acquired by negotiation and purchase or by condemnation,
2 if necessary, as provided by law.

3 Section 4. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same
4 hereby are repealed.

5 Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and
6 publication according to law, but construction shall not be commenced until ordered by resolution
7 by the City Council.


