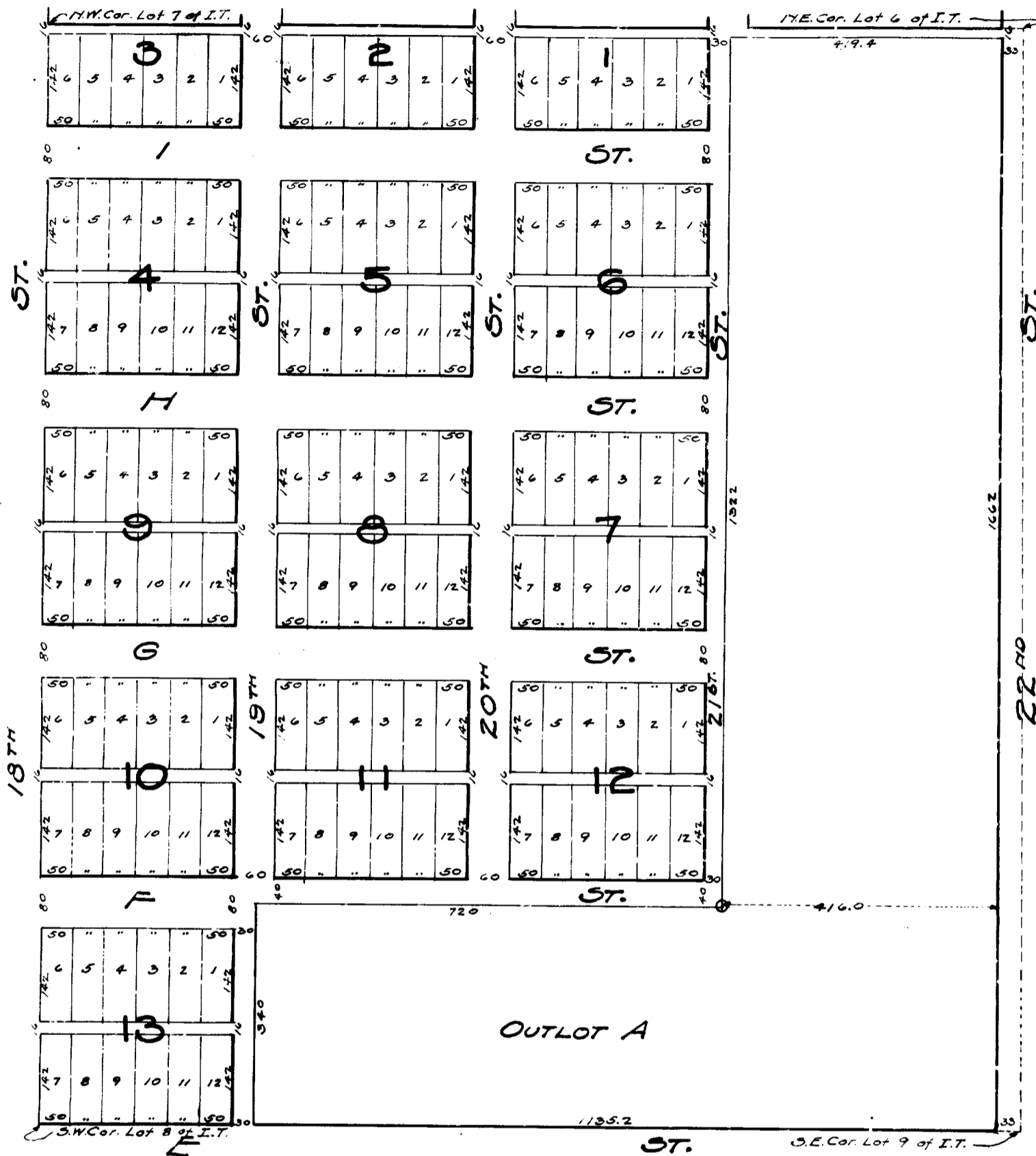


# WOODS BROS. SECOND ADDITION TO HAVELOCK
