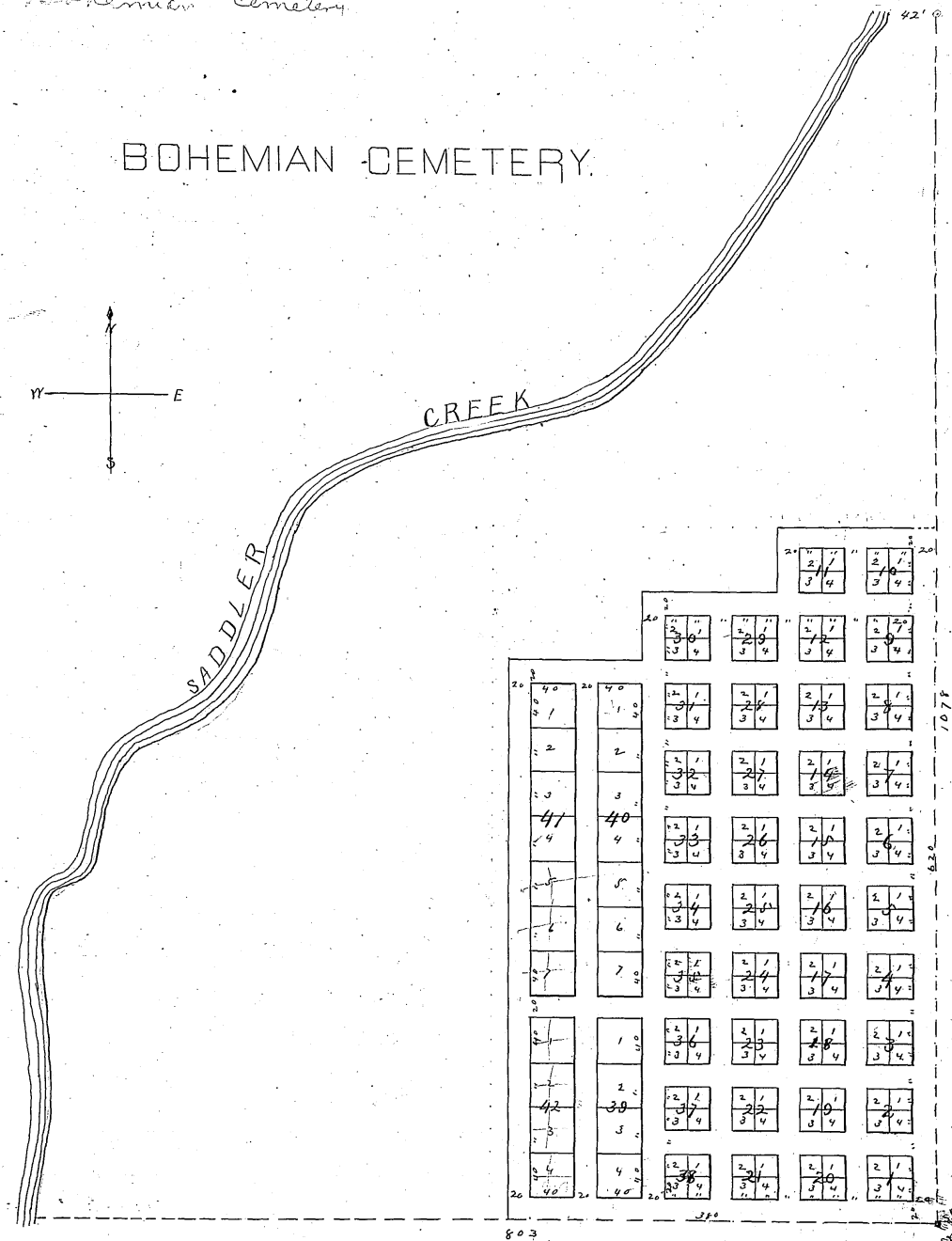
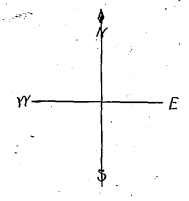


34 Plat Bohemian Cemetery

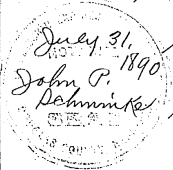
