Greeting. Homestead Certificate No. 1943  
Application No. 4465½ and 4466  
Whereas there has been deposited in the  
General Land Office of the United States

at Beatrice Nebraska containing one hundred and fifty acres according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General. Now know ye that there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Timothy M Stanclift the tract of land above described to have and to hold the said said tract of Land with the appurtenances therof unto the said Timothy M Stanclift and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof I Ulysses S Grant President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the City of Washington the first day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy five and of the Independence of the United States the Thirty Ninth
