its associated and allied companies, its and their respective successors, assigns, licensees and agents, a right of way and equipment to construct, operate, maintain, replace and remove such communication systems as the grantee may from time to time require, consisting of underground cables, wires, conduits and manholes, ducts and splicing boxes, and surface testing-terminals, repeaters, repeater housings and markers, and other appurtenances, upon, over and under a strip of land one rod wide across the land which the undersigned owns or in which the undersigned has
(has) any interest in the South One Half of the Southwest Quarter (S^W SW^Q) except tract
of land 150 feet square in the NW corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest
Quarter (SW^Q SW^Q) all of Section Five (5) in
Twp. 74 North of Range 43 West, County of Pottawattamie, State of Iowa,

together with the following rights: Of ingress and egress over and across the lands of the undersigned to and from said strip for the purpose of exercising the rights herein granted; to place surface markers beyond said strip; to clear and keep cleared all trees, roots, brush and other obstructions from the surface and subsurface of said strip and within seven feet thereof; and to install gates and gates in any fence crossing said strip. The northerly boundary of said one rod strip shall be a line parallel to and five feet NORTHERLY of the first cable laid, which cable shall have its location indicated upon surface markers set at intervals on the land of the undersigned or on adjacent lands. The undersigned for themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, hereby covenant(s) that no structure shall be erected or permitted on said strip. The grantees agree that the said cables shall be buried below depth in order not to interfere with the ordinary cultivation of the strip, and to pay for damage to fences and growing crops arising from the construction and maintenance of the
