**TAMA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 11**

**Title:** AN ORDINANCE COMPILING A CODE OF ORDINANCES, REPEALING THE ORDINANCES NUMBERED 2, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 380, Zoning Ordinance of 1998, Subdivision Regulation Ordinance, and Airport Tall Structure Zoning Ordinance, AND ADOPTING NEW ORDINANCES NUMBERED I.1, I.2, I.3 II.1, II.2, IV.1, IV.2, IV.3, IV.4, IV.5, IV.6, IV.7, V.1, V.2, V.3, V.4, V.5, V.6, V.7, VI.1, VI.2, VI.3, VII.1, VII.2, and VIII.1 REPLACING THE CURRENT ORDINANCES; TO AMEND AND REPLACE THE REPEALED ORDINANCES OF THE SAME TITLE; AND RE-ADOPTING THE REMAINING EXISTING TAMA COUNTY ORDINANCES.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Tama County, Iowa:

**SECTION 1. Purpose.** Iowa Code Section 331.302 (9) requires that once every five years a county compile a Code of Ordinances. This Ordinance repeals Ordinances numbered 2, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 380, Zoning Ordinance of 1998, Subdivision Regulation Ordinance, and Airport Tall Structure Zoning Ordinance and any versions adopted prior to the adoption of this Ordinance; adopts new Ordinances numbered I.1, I.2, I.3 II.1, II.2, IV.1, IV.2, IV.3, IV.4, IV.5, IV.6, IV.7, V.1, V.2, V.3, V.4, V.5, V.6, VI.1, VI.2, VI.3, VII.1, VII.2, and VIII.1; to amend and replace the repealed ordinances of the same title, to amend and replace the repealed ordinances of the same numbers; re-adopts the Ordinances already in effect; and compiles all such ordinances adopted or re-adopted and not repealed in a Code of Ordinances for Tama County.

**SECTION 2. Ordinances Repealed.** The following previously-adopted ordinances, identified by ordinance number and subject matter, are hereby repealed, provided that a) any ordinance or part of an ordinance that was repealed by an ordinance hereby repealed shall not be enforceable or considered re-adopted and b) the repeal shall not operate to release or relinquish any penalty, forfeiture or liability incurred under each such ordinance, and each such repealed ordinance shall be treated as remaining in force for the purpose of instituting or sustaining any proper action or prosecution for enforcement of such penalty, forfeiture, or liability:

The Tama County Board of Supervisors met at 9:30 a.m., March 1, 2005. Present: 1st District Supervisor, Larry Vest; 2nd District Supervisor, Keith Sash; and 3rd District Supervisor, Patrick Henry.

Motion by Sash, Seconded by Henry to approve the minutes for the February 22nd meeting. All Voted Aye. Motion Carried.

At 9:30, the Board met with Lyle Brehm, County Engineer, to receive a road projects report.

Motion by Vest, Seconded by Sash to approve the liquor license renewal application and outdoor services area for Traer Golf & Country Club, Traer, All Voted Aye. Motion Carried.

The Board held the Third and Final Reading of the ordinance to re-codify the Tama County Code of Ordinances. The ordinance to re-codify was reviewed. 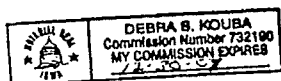

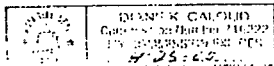

The ordinances specified under Sections 3, 4, and 5 of this Ordinance are readopted or adopted, as the case may be, and compiled as the Tama County 2005 Code of Ordinances. Copies of the Code shall be on file and available for public inspection in the Office of the County Auditor.

SECTION 7. When Effective.

This ordinance shall be effective after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
