

Richards vs Oms S. W. R. Co ✓

We the undersigned disinterested freeholders and commissioners appointed by the Probate Judge of Douglas County to appraise the damages accruing to Henry Richards by reason of the appropriation of that part of the following described real estate taken for right of way by the Omaha and South Western Railroad Company situated in Douglas County Nebraska as shown on the plat and profile of said road filed and attached to this award to wit: a strip of land one hundred feet wide, being fifty feet on each side of the center line of said road through one acre of land in the South thirty two rods of Lot four (4) in Section twenty three (23) in Township fifteen (15) North of Range thirteen (13) East this same having been conveyed by Noble B. Hays and wife to Henry Richards May 25<sup>th</sup> 1866, having been duly qualified and having each personally examined said premises on the day and at the time mentioned in the notice hereto attached, did at the Office of said Probate Judge of said County find said damages to amount to the following sum to wit: One hundred and fifty dollars, and we hereby accordingly award and appraise said damages at the total sum of One hundred and fifty Dollars.
