

ORDINANCE NO. 27954

AN ORDINANCE vacating North-South Alley between 11th Street and 12th Street from Briggs Street North to East-West Alley, also the South East-West Alley between vacated Pierce Street and Briggs Street from 11th Street to 12th Street, located in the Northeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$), Section 27-15-13, and providing the effective date hereof.

WHEREAS, under Section 14-375, Reissue, Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, provides that the City Council may vacate a street or alley without petition upon City Planning Board recommendation; and,

WHEREAS, the Statute further provides that a Committee of Appraisers be appointed to appraise damages, if any, to property affected by the vacation; and,

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 3496 adopted July 17, 1973, appointed Jerry Hassett, Monta Taylor and John Hlavacek, members of the City Council, to assess damages to all property affected by the vacation; and

WHEREAS, on September 28, 1976, the Committee of Appraisers held a meeting at 1:30 P.M., in the Council Chamber of the City of Omaha; and,

WHEREAS, the Committee of Appraisers found no cause for any damages as a result of the vacation; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council finds there are no damages as a result of this vacation.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAHA:

Section 1. That the North-South Alley between 11th Street and 12th Street from Briggs Street North to East-West Alley, also the South East-West Alley between vacated Pierce Street and Briggs Street from 11th Street to 12th Street, located in the Northeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$), Section 27-15-13

be, and hereby is, vacated; the vacating of the property herein described, and the reversion thereof, pursuant to applicable law, shall be subject to the conditions and limitation that there is reserved to the City of Omaha

the right to maintain, operate, repair and renew sewers now existing therein and in the future to construct, maintain, repair and renew additional or other sewers, also the right to authorize the Metropolitan Utilities District of the City of Omaha or any other public utility to construct, maintain, repair or renew and operate now existing or hereafter installed water mains, pole lines, conduits and other similar services or equipment above, on and below the surface of the ground for the purpose of serving the general public or abutting property; and the right so reserved shall also include such lateral connection or branch lines as may be ordered, desired or permitted by the City and to enter upon the premises to accomplish the above purpose at any and all times.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force fifteen (15) days from and after the date of its passage.

Honorable President

and Members of the City Council,

Transmitted herewith is an Ordinance for the proposed vacation of the following:

North-South Alley between 11th Street and 12th Street from Briggs Street North to East-West Alley, also the South East-West Alley between vacated Pierce Street and Briggs Street from 11th Street to 12th Street, located in Northeast Quarter (¼), Section 27-15-13.

The approval of the City Planning Board at its meeting held April 21, 1976, is attached. A petition was not required since Section 14-375 Reissue, Revised Statutes of Nebraska, provides, "Upon the recommendation of the City Planning Board, the City Council may, by Ordinance or Resolution, vacate any street or alley within any such City without any petition being filed therefore", also "Before any such street or alley shall be vacated, the Council shall appoint a Committee of at least three members thereof who shall faithfully and impartially and after reasonable notice to the owners and parties interested in the property affected by such vacation, assess damages, if any, to such owners and parties affected."

On September 28, 1976, the Committee of Appraisers held a meeting at 1:30 P.M., in the Council Chamber of the City of Omaha and found no cause for any damages as a result of the vacation.

The form of the attached documents have been approved by the City Law Department.

The Housing and Community Development Department wish to vacate the above described alleys and being a non-taxable body, cannot submit a petition to vacate subject alleys, therefore, this request was initiated by the Planning Board.

WHEREAS, Section 14-375, Reissue, Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, provides that "upon the recommendation of the City Planning Board, the City Council may, by ordinance or resolution, vacate any street or alley within any such city without any petition being filed therefore." It further provides that "Before any such street or alley shall be vacated, the Council shall appoint a committee of at least three members thereof who shall faithfully and impartially and after reasonable notice to the owners and parties interested in the property affected by the vacation, assess the damages, if any, to such owners and parties affected," and,

WHEREAS, on July 17, 1973, the City Council of the City of Omaha appointed Jerry Hassett, Monte Taylor and John Hlavacek, members of the City Council of the City of Omaha as a committee to assess damages, if any, to such owners and parties affected by the vacation of above said right of way, and,
