

1	WHEREAS, Potential II, L.L.C. has submitted an application designated as
2	Special Permit No. 04010 for authority to sell alcoholic beverages for consumption on the
3	premises generally located at 7301 South 27th Street, legally described as:
4 5 6	Lot 1, Block 1, Tamarin Ridge Addition, located in the South Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 24, Township 9 North, Range 6 East of the 6th P.M., Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska; and
7	WHEREAS, the real property adjacent to the area included within the site plan
8	for this permit to sell alcoholic beverages on the premises will not be adversely affected; and
9	WHEREAS, said site plan together with the terms and conditions hereinafter
10	set forth are consistent with the intent and purpose of Title 27 of the Lincoln Municipal Code
11	to promote the public health, safety, and general welfare.
12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of
13	Lincoln, Nebraska:
14	That the application of Potential II, L.L.C., hereinafter referred to as "Permittee",
15	to sell alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises on property legally described
16	above be and the same is hereby granted under the provisions of Section 27.63.680 of the
17	Lincoln Municipal Code upon condition that operation of said licensed premises be in strict
18	compliance with said application, the site plan, and the following additional express terms,
19	conditions, and requirements:
20	1. This permit approves the sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption
21	on the premises only at 7301 South 27th Street.

- 3. The site plan, approved by this permit, shall be the basis for all interpretations of setbacks, yards, locations of buildings, location of parking and circulation elements, and similar matters.
- 4. The terms, conditions, and requirements of this resolution shall be binding and obligatory upon the Permittee, its successors, and assigns. The building official shall report violations to the City Council which may revoke the special permit or take such other action as may be necessary to gain compliance.
- 5. The Permittee shall sign and return the City's letter of acceptance to the City Clerk within 30 days following approval of the special permit, provided, however, said 30-day period may be extended up to six months by administrative amendment. The City Clerk shall file a copy of the resolution approving the special permit and the letter of acceptance with the Register of Deeds, filing fees therefor to be paid in advance by the Permittee.
