**ARTICLE I
Spouse**

I am married and my spouse's name is LENORE H. POLACK. Throughout this Will she shall be referred to as "my spouse".

**ARTICLE II
Debts and Expenses**

I direct that the expenses of my last illness and funeral be paid as soon as practicable after my death.
