Transmitted herewith is an Ordinance requested by the Planning Department providing for the granting of a permanent easement to the Omaha Public Power District for underground electric facilities and appurtenances on lot 22, Gallup University Riverfront Campus in order to serve the National Park Services facility.

The easement will allow a connection with the existing OPPD easement on Lot 22 and provide for service to the National Park Services facility. The granting of this easement will not hamper the future use of these lots nor diminish the value of the property.

This Ordinance authorizes the Mayor to execute the attached easement and right-of-way agreement that will grant the Omaha Public Power District a permanent easement for underground electric facilities within Lots 22, Gallup University Riverfront Campus, a subdivision surveyed, platted and recorded in Douglas County, Nebraska.

Your favorable consideration of this Ordinance is requested.

RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT

CITY OF OMAHA, Owner of the real estate described as follows, and hereafter referred to as "Grantor",

Lot 22, Gallup University Riverfront Campus, a subdivision surveyed, platted and recorded in Douglas County, Nebraska.

in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant to the OMAHA PUBLIC POWER DISTRICT, a public corporation, its successors and assigns, hereafter referred to as "District", a permanent right of way easement with rights of ingress and egress thereto, to construct, operate, maintain, replace and remove its underground electric facilities, consisting of cables, wires, conduits, manholes, drains, splicing boxes and other appurtenances, upon, over, along and under the following described real estate, to wit:

A tract of land located in Lot 22, Gallup University Riverfront Campus, a subdivision as surveyed, platted and recorded in Douglas County, Nebraska, being more particularly described as follows: Referring to the Northwest corner of Lot 20 of said subdivision, said point also being a corner on the East line of said lot 22; thence S 00° 00'00" E (assumed Bearing), 87.78 feet on the East line of said Lot 22; thence N 44° 57'04" W, 152.19 feet on the south line of an existing Utility and Access Easement to Lot 20, to the Point of Beginning; thence S 82° 14'15" W, 76.60 feet to the East line of an existing 40.00 foot easement to the Omaha Public Power District (OPPD); thence N 12°32 '18" E, 10.02 feet on the East line of said existing OPPD easement; thence N 04°41'50" E, 10.85 feet on the East line of said OPPD easement; thence N 82° 14'15" E, 55.61 feet to the south line of said Utility and Access Easement; thence S 44° 57'04" E, 25.11 feet on the south line of said Utility and Access Easement to the Point of Beginning. (See Exhibit "A" on the reverse side hereof for a drawing of the easement area)

CONDITIONS:

The Grantor hereby grants to the District, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to clear all trees, roots, brush, and other obstructions from the surface and subsurface of said strip and to temporarily open any fences crossing said strip. Grantor agrees that grade shall not be reduced more than One foot (1') in elevation without the prior approval of the District.

In granting this easement, it is understood that said cables shall be buried below plow depth in order to not interfere with the ordinary cultivation of the strip. Damages to fences and growing crops arising from the construction and maintenance of the aforesaid system shall be paid for by the District.

The Grantor covenants that it has lawful possession of said real estate, good, right and lawful authority to make such conveyance and that its successors and assigns shall warrant and defend the same and will indemnify and hold harmless the District forever against the claims of all persons whomsoever in any way asserting any right, title or interest prior to or contrary to this conveyance.



ORDINANCE NO. , 364//

AN ORDINANCE to grant the Omaha Public Power District a permanent easement and to authorize the Mayor to execute an easement and right-of-way agreement; and, providing for the effective date hereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAHA:

Section 1. That the City of Omaha, notwithstanding the procedure outlined in Sections 27-51 to 27-75 of the Omaha Municipal Code, will grant to the Omaha Public Power District a permanent easement to the extent identified in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and to the extent it has any interest in the following piece of property:

Lots 22, Gallup University Riverfront Campus, a subdivision surveyed, platted and recorded in Douglas County, Nebraska.

Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of Omaha shall be authorized to execute the easement and right-of-way agreement attached to this Ordinance.
