Omaha, Nebr. March 20, 1962

RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAHA:

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department of the City of Omaha has requested an Easement from the Union Pacific Railroad Company, a Corporation of the State of Utah, for the purposes of constructing, operating, maintaining, repairing, renewing and reconstructing thereon of interceptor sewer pipe lines, varying in sizes from 24 inches to 66 inches in internal diameter and a sewer lift station in conjunction with the South Omaha Interceptor Sewer No. 2182, upon the property and under the tracks of the Union Pacific Railroad Company, locations as shown on Exhibits "A" and "B", attached hereto; and,

WHEREAS, the Union Pacific Railroad Company has submitted a Deed covering said Easement, as requested, for the constructing, operating, maintaining, repairing, renewing and reconstructing thereon, of interceptor sewer pipe lines varying in sizes from 24 inches to 66 inches in internal diameter and a sewer lift station in conjunction with the South Omaha Interceptor Sewer No. 2182; upon the property and under the tracks of said Railroad Company, locations as shown on Exhibits "A" and "B" attached to said Deed; and

WHEREAS, the City Legal Department has approved the Deed as to form; and,

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department recommends the acceptance of the Deed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAHA:

THAT, the City of Omaha accept the Deed, covering an Easement, for the construction, operating, maintaining, repairing, renewing and reconstructing thereon, of interceptor sewer pipe lines varying in sizes from 24 inches to 66 inches in internal diameter and a sewer lift station in conjunction with the South Omaha Interceptor Sewer No. 2182; upon the property and under the tracks of the Union Pacific Railroad Company, locations as shown on Exhibits "A" and "B" attached to said Deed.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

THAT, the Department of Public Works is hereby authorized and directed to record said Deed in the Office of the Register of Deeds of Douglas County, Nebraska, thereafter filed with the Department of Parks, Recreation and Public Property.
