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RESOLUTION - EXHIBIT I BURLINGTON HEADQUARTERS BUILDING LANDMARK DESIGNATION LANDMARK HERHAGE PRESERVATION COMMISSION

RESOLVED BY THE LANDMARKS HERITAGE PRESERVATION COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OMAHA:

WHEREAS, the City of Omaha is the owner of the Burlington Headquarters Building; and,

WHEREAS, Mayor Al Veys, on behalf of the City of Omaha, on July 19, 1978, requested that the Burlington Headquarters Building be designated as a Landmark under the City of Omaha's Landmarks Heritage Preservation Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, the Burlington Headquarters Building was designed in its present state by nationally known Omaha architect Thomas Kimball; and,

WHEREAS, the Burlington Headquarters Building exemplifies the Italiannate Style of architecture used in many commercial structures of the late 19th Century; and,

WHEREAS, the Burlington Headquarters Building is penetrated by a unique 4-story skylit court surrounded by galleries and staircases of cast iron and oak; and,

WHEREAS, the Burlington Headquarters Building is on the National Register of Historic Places.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LANDMARKS HERITAGE PRESERVATION COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OMAHA:

IHAT, the Burlington Headquarters Building, 1004 Farnam Street, be designated as a Landmark of the City of Omaha.

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
