to lay connect and maintain a sewer pipe, from the

platted and recorded, Through the partition wall and  
into the sewer pipe now laid and situated on the East  
Twenty two feet (22 ft) of the West fifty five feet (55 ft)  
of said Lot four (4) in said Block One hundred and  
Twenty (120) at or about forty feet from the South end  
of said Lot on the line between the said West (33 ft)  
Thirty Three feet and East Twenty Two (22 ft) of the West  
fifty five (55 ft) of said Lot, and that said James J.  
Brown shall have the right to enter upon the said  
Twenty Two feet to repair said sewer.

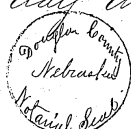
