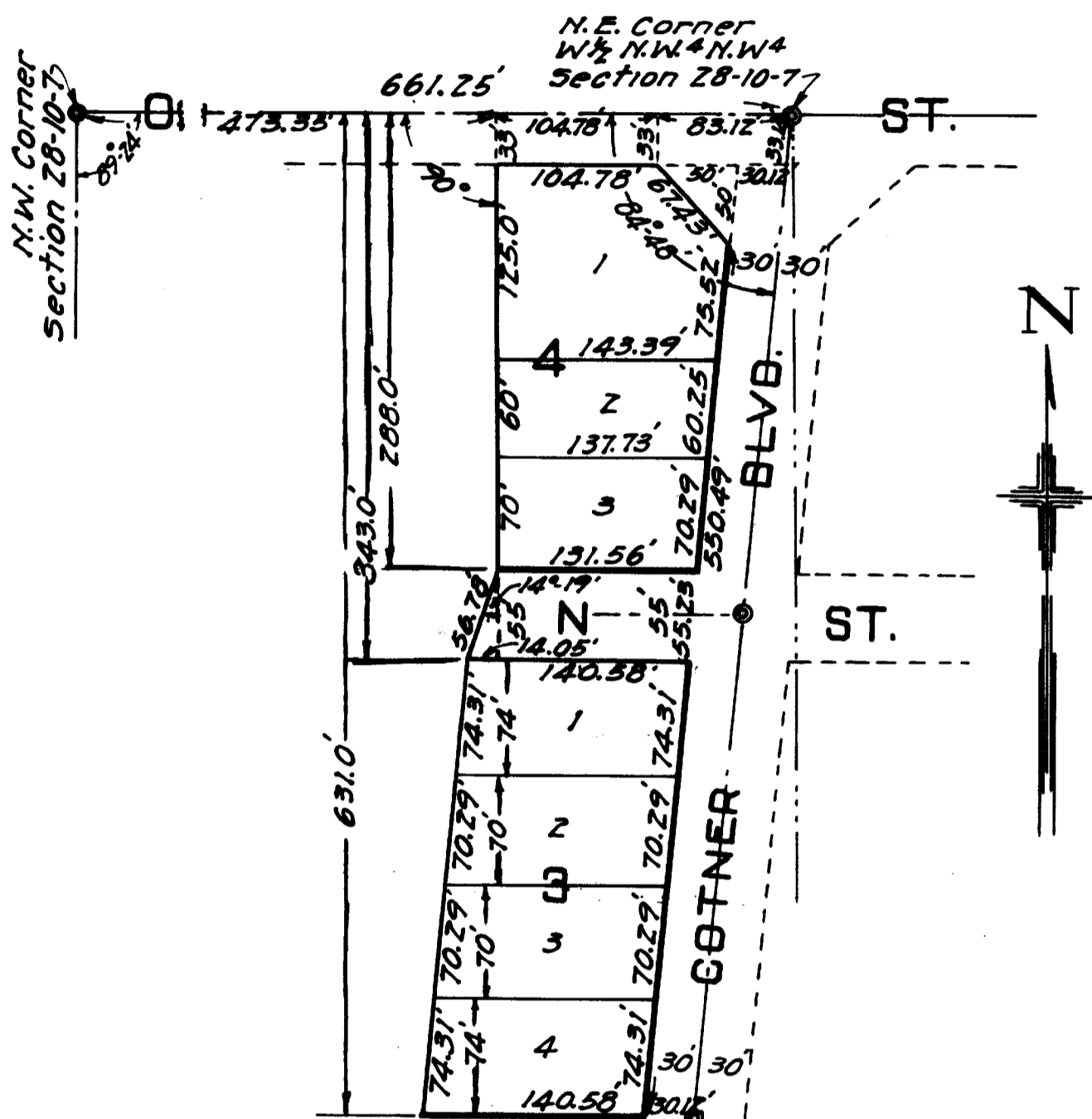


EASTMONT

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DEDICATION

We, Max W. Taylor and Rebecca C. Taylor, husband and wife, sole owners of lot 23 and E. S. Josephine Taylor and A.O. Taylor, wife and husband, sole owners of lot 24, all being irregular tract lots in the N.W.4 N.W.4 of Section 28 T.10N., R.7.E., of the 6th P.M., Lancaster County, Nebraska, do hereby subdivide and plat said irregular tract lots 23 and 24 as Blocks 3 and 4 "EASTMONT AN ADDITION TO LINCOLN, NEBRASKA," as the same appears on the foregoing plat, and the platting of the same is with the free consent and in accordance with the desire of the undersigned sole owners and proprietors. The streets shown thereon are hereby dedicated to the use of the public, together with an easement on the westerly two feet of each lot for the construction and maintenance of pole lines.
